

If there is one thing all parents have in common, it's the fear something will happen to their child. And of special concern is the fear it will happen when the child is with a babysitter . . . When the parent is not there to take charge.

A Source of Important Medical Information About Your Child

To help in these situations, we strongly encourage you to complete the Emergency Care Form in this brochure and leave it with your babysitter. The form contains medical information about your child that can be

vitaly important should an emergency arise. It also contains a place for you to write where you'll be and how you can be reached in case of an emergency.

Authorizing Treatment For Your Children

The staff of the Wayne HealthCare Emergency Room must have your permission before they can treat your children as long as those children are under the age of 18 and unmarried.

In non-life threatening situations, such as those most often seen at the hospital, the staff, by law, must await your permission to treat your child. (That permission must come from parents or legal guardians. Under the law, it cannot come from brothers, sisters or even grandparents.)

Of course, if the situation is life-threatening, the staff will immediately provide needed treatment.

In the event of an emergency, we will do everything in our power to contact you as quickly as possible so you can come to the hospital to sign the require consent form.

When you are Out of Town

If you are going out of town and leaving your children in the care of a babysitter or with family, you can give them the power to authorize treatment for your child by signing

the appropriate space on the Emergency Care form. Please instruct your babysitter to bring the form with them to Wayne HealthCare should an emergency arise.
