





AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) Maintenance Program

Wayne HealthCare Foundation in partnership with Midmark Corporation and Spirit Medical Transport are honored to serve this community and your organization by providing your AED.

We hope that your AED is in good working condition and ask that you periodically do a maintenance check to make sure your batteries are in good working order and your pads are not expired.

We offer you a maintenance program to keep your AED in good working order so it will always be ready in case of an emergency. AED models in our program include Philips HeartStart model M6077, which was distributed from 2008-2021, and HeartSine 350p which began in distribution in 2022.

AED Manufacturer warranties typically are 8 years for the unit, 4 years for the battery and 2 years for pads. You can call your manufacturer in that time if there are issues.

Batteries and Pads

You are the owner of the AED and liable for its maintenance. Wayne HealthCare Foundation offers battery and pad replacements at a discount of retail pricing. Call Lauren Henry at 937-569-6408 or email <u>lauren.henry@waynehealthcare.org</u> to place your order and discuss possible grant opportunities for this maintenance. We will need the serial number and model number of the AED as well as the battery number and type of pad you need.

If your check shows that the batteries or pads are expired, please take the AED out of operation immediately and obtain replacements before putting it back in service.

CPR & AED Training

CPR training is necessary when operating your AED. When new staff and volunteers join your organization, it is a great time to call our partner, Spirit Emergency Medical Services at 937-548-2800, and check out their schedule of CPR trainings for your caring staff & volunteers to attend. There is a small fee for CPR/AED training, and if you have a staff member or volunteer that has never had this training, please call Wayne HealthCare Foundation to see about scholarship eligibility for this course.
