COVID-19 VISITOR RESTRICTIONS

Amended May 22, 2020

Hospital/Emergency Department/Outpatient Visitors

- All hospitalized patients may have one (1) visitor/support person.
- Visitation or support persons for office visits may vary by provider. Patients are encouraged to check with individual providers to ensure they are clear on their provider's policy.
- No visitation will be allowed by anyone under the age of 18, unless they are the parent or legal guardian of a pediatric patient.
- No visitation will be permitted for outpatient testing, such as routine x-rays, non-invasive radiology testing, and lab tests.
- The following exceptions allow for more than one (1) visitor/support person:
 - For end-of-life or life-threatening situations.
 - For maternity patients.
 - Minor patients (<18 years old).
 - For patients who require assistance due to mobility, reorienting/confusion (patient safety), interpretation, court-ordered, or healthcare decision making.
 - No visitation is allowed for confirmed or suspected COVID-19 cases (unless above criteria is met).

All visitors will be screened daily and allowed in only if they appear healthy and have no symptoms of illness.



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
